
## What can you do to use less water?

Most of the water used in the Coachella Valley is used outdoors. Make sure that you're doing what you can in the yard to stop water waste. Changing your behavior around the house can save on monthly water bills and help protect our precious resource.





Change your irrigation controller with the seasons. Grass and plants don't require as much water during the cooler months. Or, make things easier on yourself by installing a smart irrigation controller that automatically adjusts with the weather. DESERT WATER

water use restrictions are now in effect in DWA's service area:  Washing of hardscapes is prohibited.

- Outdoor irrigation shall be restricted to Mondays,
  Wednesdays and Fridays,
  before 7:00 a.m. and
  after 7:00 p.m.
- Irrigating up to 48 hours after measurable rainfall is prohibited.
- Using potable water outside of newly constructed homes and buildings that is not delivered by drip or microspray systems is prohibited.

- Runoff such that water flows onto adjacent property, nonirrigated areas, private and public walkways, roadways, parking lots, or structures is prohibited.
- Restaurants may provide water to customers only upon request.
- The use of potable water to irrigate turf within street medians, and turf within the dedicated right of way on either side of a public street, is prohibited.

- Running water to wash vehicles is prohibited (buckets and stop nozzles on hoses are permitted).
- Operators of hotels and motels shall provide guests with the option of choosing not to have towels and linens laundered daily.
- Agency customers are encouraged not to empty and refill swimming pools from June 1 through October 31 unless necessary to address a health or safety emergency.
